with over 25,400 staff worldwide.



## Our Results (in 2023)



Around 57,800 tonnes of Co2 equivalent/year greenhouse gas emissions were reduced or avoided.



Over 24,700 people gained access to modern energy supply for the first time or improved access to energy supply.



Electrical energy consumption was reduced by around 458 MWhel/a.



Over 1.6 million people benefited from access to improved administrative services.



Around 1.3 million people accessed digital public services.



Over 166 people participated in municipal, regional or national policy/decision-making process, including over 30 women.



Around 11.7 million people, including over 6 million women, have received healthcare services or access hereto.



213 healthcare facilities were built or strengthened.



Over 175 million people benefitted from financial risk protection in relation to general healthcare.



Around 126,000 people received basic social protection.



Over 884,100 people, including over 417,200 women, received a better quality of school education.



Around 1,990 people, including over 300 women, successfully completed vocational training courses.



Over 3,260 jobs were created or secured.



More than 7,800 people benefitted from improved working conditions.



More than 1.4 million members of refugees and host communities, including over 800,000 women, were supported.
